Class Act Shoe/Undergarment Requirements

Please read the following shoe & undergarment requirements below for all cast members. Please have all required items by the **COSTUME PARADE**, and earlier if possible. Parents of minors are responsible for providing the following items for their child by the costume parade as well. These undergarments are required for ALL cast members both for modesty and to protect microphone equipment. Please order early so that they will be in on time. If you do have questions, please contact Heika DeHart at 281-475-8722 as soon as possible.

Undergarments - females

- All females should wear [nude leotards with clear straps](#) or [nude camisole](#) with white or [nude bootie shorts](#) (found at Amazon, Academy, Jazz Rags, Wal-Mart, etc.) These items should be kept on throughout each dress rehearsal and performance.
- You may choose to also wear [nude tights](#). I recommend purchasing two pairs to be prepared for the inevitable run. Jazz Rags is close to the studio, has a huge selection and has “frequent buyer” cards. If you wear tights and a leotard, it is recommended that tights are worn over the leotard. Trust me on this!
- No visible bra straps or camisole/leotard straps when wearing costumes.

Undergarments – males

- All males should wear a white, snug-fitting, [undershirt shirt](#) and snug-fitting, light underwear, or tight-fitting bike shorts (no basketball shorts).
- Have at least one pair of long black socks, should be long enough that when on stage, the audience cannot see the skin at ankles. These should be worn with slacks or jeans. Some costumes may require additional socks, but you will be notified if you need to provide these.



SHOES

- All females who are playing adults in the show (this includes the servants, nanny, costume mistress, and any teens who are park goers) please have [high heeled lace up boots](#) similar to these in black. If you are unable to get these boots please have [Character shoes](#) in black.
- All children (including younger park goers, George, Jack, Peter, Michael, and children in prologue) please have black jazz shoes
- All men, James and Leo please have black dress shoes unless I talk with you about having brown
- All Pirates need tall boots. We have some pairs still in the costume room but no guarantees that we will have your size. Please come by SOON to see if we have your size, otherwise you will need to order some.

COSTUME AND WARDROBE FAQs

1. CAN I TAKE MY COSTUME HOME?

No. All costume items REMAIN at Class Act Productions for the entirety of the run. Please do not remove to launder or use for personal use. All items loaned to you by Class Act must be returned to Class Act or you will be responsible for the cost. You may take your own personal items home after the run. We encourage you to clearly LABEL your own items with your name.

2. MY COSTUME NEEDS MENDING OR CLEANING CAN I TAKE IT HOME?

No. If your costume needs repair or cleaning we will handle it for you. We will launder or clean costumes regularly to keep

you feeling your best! Please let us know if there is an issue with your costume.

3. WHY DO I NEED TO WEAR THESE UNDERGARMENTS?

Please wear your undergarments so that everyone can feel comfortable in the changing spaces. We appreciate your cooperation with this! The undergarments also help to protect expensive microphone equipment from being damaged.

Courtesy Rules of Costumes

1. **No food or drink** in the dressing rooms and do not consume while in costume! Only water or lozenges.
2. **Hang it up!** Each item on its own hanger, pants on clips.
3. Don't touch anyone else's costumes.
4. Confirm **your name** is in your costume before putting on and after hanging up.
5. Don't change a costume item without approval from the Costume head or creative team.
6. Please keep your accessories in your basket!
7. Please keep your area tidy and wipe up make-up spills.
8. Do not remove any costumes from the studio until the end of run and then **ONLY** costumes you purchased.
